Health Sciences Recruitment & Admissions

- As of September 2024, all incoming Fall 2025 Health Sciences program students will be required to complete admission prerequisite coursework by June 30, 2025. Aligned with Norman Campus' incoming student deadline, this adjustment is to ensure the processing of student records, confirm enrollment prior to orientation and first day of classes, ensure financial aid disbursement, and student health insurance access. If an admitted student is unable to complete admission requirements by June 30, 2025, students can submit a Prerequisite Waiver. Students should only complete the waiver after they are offered admission to a program that starts in Fall 2025. To start the Fall 2025 Prerequisite Waiver process, please visit [here](#).

College of Allied Health

- A Graduate Record Education (GRE) test score is no longer needed for any College of Allied Health programs. *

College of Dentistry

- For the Doctor of Dental Surgery (DDS) program, Advanced Placement (AP) classes will only be allowed for English and Psychology. This is a clarification of the current process.

Fran & Earl Ziegler College of Nursing

- The required prerequisite courses for admission to the Traditional Bachelor of Nursing (TBSN) program have not changed. As of September 2024, individuals applying to the TBSN program will need to complete two of the four required science courses before submitting their application. This adjustment is to ensure a student's science performance is aligned with the program demands and remove the hardship of additional graduation requirements during the program. This adjustment is reflected in the Nursing Central Application System.
- Aligned with other Health Sciences programs, Ziegler College of Nursing programs will calculate an applicant's science grade point average (GPA) from all earned science courses. This is a clarification of the current application process for Fall 2025.

College of Medicine

- Over the next five years, the College of Medicine Medical Doctor (MD) program will increase from 163 students to 232 students. * Check out the news story [here](#).
