- PROGRAM REQUEST – Doctor of Philosophy in Health Policy
 - Admissions Requirements: Completion of the Master of Public Health (MPH) in Health Policy from the Department of Health Administration and Policy with a minimum GPA of 3.4 or a comparable master's level or professional degree; formally admitted into the Ph.D. program based on the recommendation of the program director/admissions committee and approval of the dean; writing sample that demonstrates analytical and research abilities; statement of purpose outlining academic and professional background, motivation for pursuing a Ph.D. in Health Policy, career objectives and research interests; how the Ph.D. program aligns with their professional goals; and how the individual intends to contribute to the field of health policy; and language proficiency for applicants whose primary language is not English.
 - Curriculum and Graduation Requirements: 90 total credit hours.
