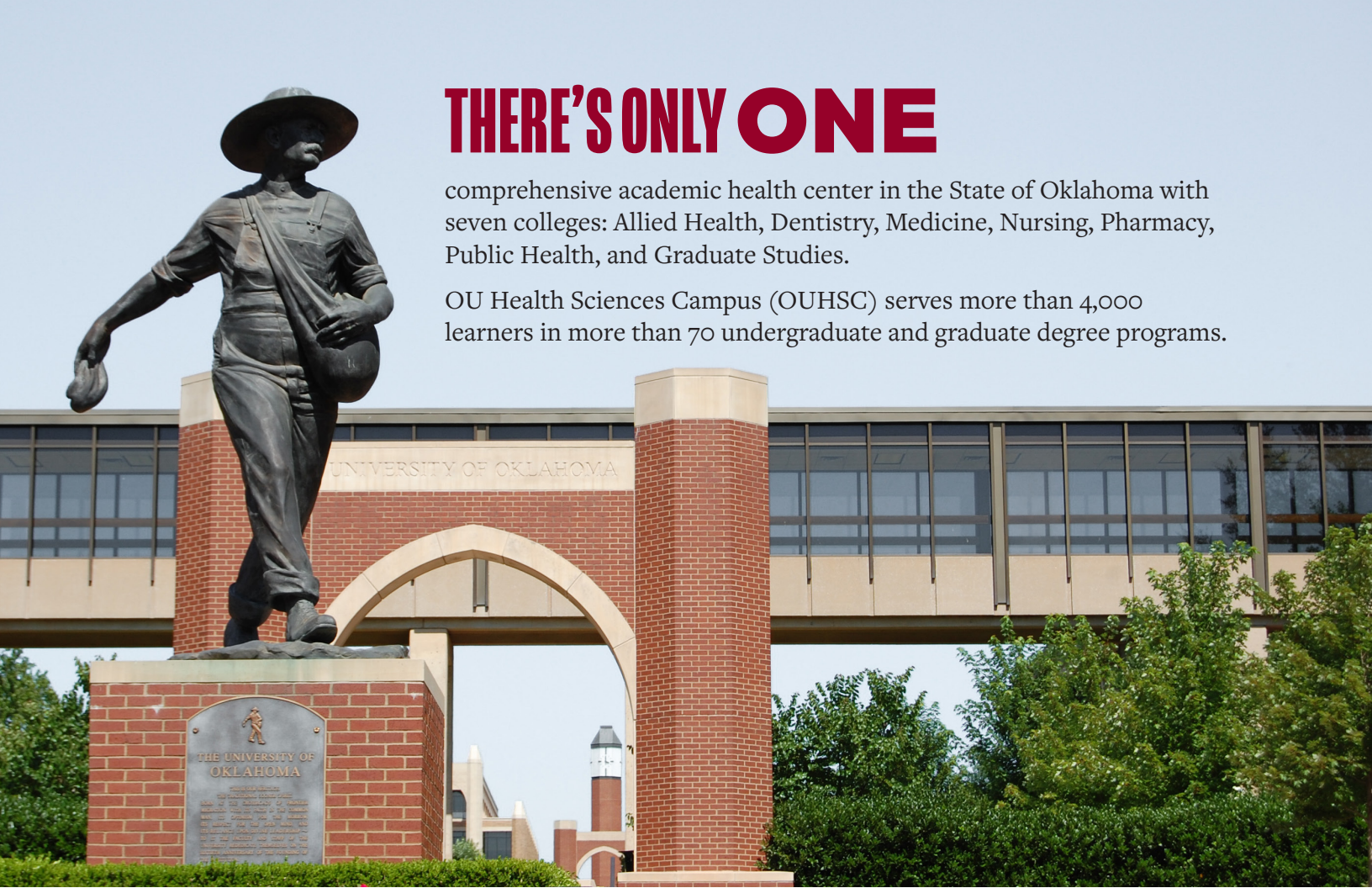

- 3 Shadow health professionals in a particular career.** Shadowing is one way to explore health careers. Try to shadow as many professions and specialties as possible.
- 4 Concentrate on academics.** Average admitted student grade point averages (GPAs) are listed below for each program.
- 5 Join the pre-professional clubs.** Whether in the community or on your campus, pre-professional clubs are a great way to interact with health professionals.
- 6 Review admissions timelines.** Each program has a unique schedule for applications. Meet with an admissions counselor at visit.ouhsc.edu.

- 8 Take applicable graduate admission exams.** Review the required exam for each program at discover.ouhsc.edu.
