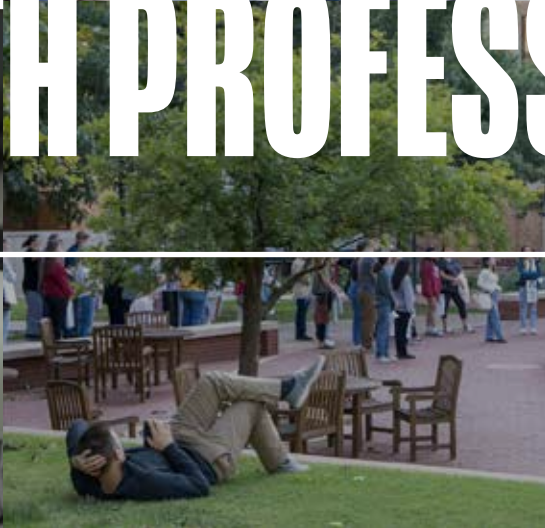

STEPS TO JOIN THE OU HEALTH SCIENCES FAMILY

- 1 Explore various health careers.** With 70+ OU Health Sciences programs, there are many avenues to a helping profession.
- 2 Visit Health Sciences prospective student website.** Learn about programs and upcoming events, schedule a campus visit, and more at discover.ouhsc.edu.
- 3 Shadow health professionals in a variety of careers.** Shadowing is one way to explore health careers. Try to shadow as many professions and specialties as possible. Find opportunities at ouhealth.com/health-professionals/ou-health-student-learners.
- 4 Concentrate on academics.** Average admitted student grade point averages (GPAs) are listed below for each program.
